

In the difficult situation of global infection of COVID-19, we had an online opening ceremony of the training courses in Seismology, Earthquake Engineering, and Tsunami Disaster Mitigation for young researchers and engineers on Oct 2nd. Seven participants from El Salvador, Chile, Bangladesh, Malaysia, and Timor-Leste began commuting to BRI on Nov 16th, followed by four participants from Indonesia and Bhutan on Dec 7th.
